give you the hardest time yet, turn right around and defend anyone who stepped sideways at his family.

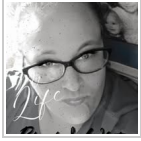
He loved his son Ethen and was a huge supporter of Ethen playing wheelchair basketball.

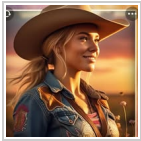
