With heavy hearts we announce the passing of Daniel Shaffer who was a proud father, grandfather, great grandfather, brother, nephew, uncle and friend.

Dan is preceded in death by his beloved mother, Betty Shaffer; father, Everett Shaffer; brother, Michael Shaffer; and oldest son, Daniel Aaron Shaffer.
