DeSean Michael Watts, born on June 22, 1995, in Dayton, Ohio, passed away peacefully at Licking Memorial Hospital in Newark, Ohio, following a traumatic seizure. He was 29 years old. DeSean's selflessness and generosity were evident in his decision to be a registered organ donor, giving the gift of life to others in need.

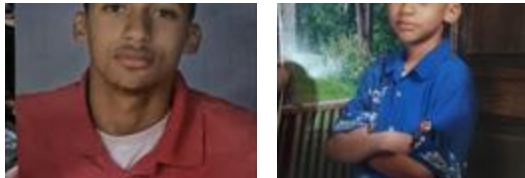
He was very family and community driven, and had no qualms going out of his way to be there in your streams, or to just have an inbox open if you needed a solid person to talk too.
