She spent many hours rifling through the racks of thrift stores, consignment shops, and yard sales to produce her signature looks, complete with a color-coordinated bandana tied around her forehead. There was always someone offering compliments on her distinctive attire everywhere she went, which pleased her greatly.

Doree was also a deeply devoted grandmother who enjoyed being a part of her grandson Eli's life, babysitting him during those tender first four years while Mom was at work. The bond she shared with him continues to this day, into his teenage years. She reveled in his accomplishments and told anyone who would listen how proud she was of him.
