Gerald “Jerry” Ahrens, age 81, passed away on August 26, 2025. Born on September 8, 1943, he was raised in Saginaw, Michigan. On June 25, 1966, Jerry married the love of his life, Jane (Witker) Ahrens, in Pemberville, Ohio. Together, they built a life on the east side of Columbus before moving to Pataskala in June 2024.

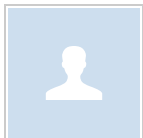
