Harold, two days shy of his 101st birthday, of Carroll, OH went home to be his Lord and his wife on October 23, 2020. He is preceded in death by his parents, Earl and Edith (Cofman) Cooper and his loving wife, Virginia (Wolfe) Cooper.
