Karl Fritz Raidel, passed away on February 14, 2023 after a long battle with Multiple Sclerosis (MS). He was born August 13, 1966 and was a long time resident of Westerville, Ohio. Fritz married his loving wife, Amy, at the age of 29. They were married for 26 years, during which they had two children, Martin and Jessica, to complete their little family.

Karl worked as a brick mason for several years before changing direction and going into garage door installation. He was a hard worker, working until his MS forced him to retire, but that didn't stop his sense of adventure. 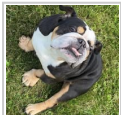
