“ WE MAY GRIEVE BUT HE SHOUTS GLORY

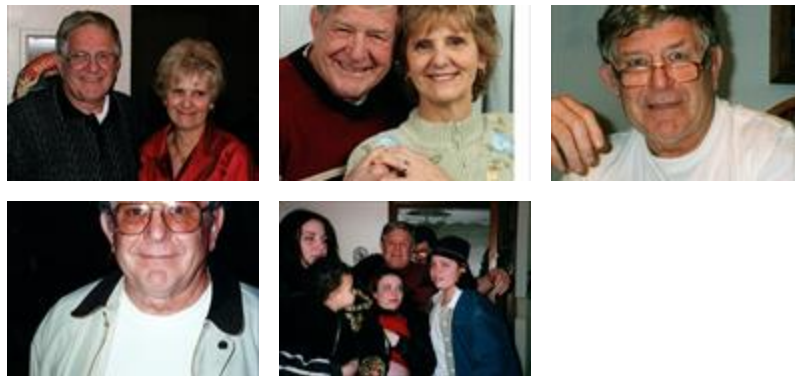
We may grieve, but he shouts GLORY in his home there in the sky,
