He met Lynnette E. Holt his last semester at MSU. They were married in July 1988 and moved to Pasadena, CA in August 1988 to attend Fuller Theological Seminary, receiving a MTheology, June 1993. Michael worked in IT as well as being involved in the music ministry at Mifflin Presbyterian Church, Gahanna.
