Michael (Mike) H. Schmidt, of Trimble, OH, passed away on Sunday, September 9, 2018 at the age of 69. Mike was born to parents, Henry and Kathleen Schmidt, on October 19, 1948 in Cincinnati, OH. He grew up as the youngest of three and attended Green Hills High School. In 1966, he joined the United States Navy and proudly served on the USS Charles F. Adams (DDG 2). After leaving the Navy, Mike worked on the Tugboat, Mark Eastern, which ran up and down the Ohio River and gained the nickname "Catfish". Later, he received training in the meat cutting industry. Though he followed a varied career path, he was an artist known for his wood carving and furniture, drawing, and cooking.
