Nancy Lee Stricker, 64, of Columbus, Ohio and formerly of Sandusky, Ohio, passed away on Feb. 3, after a lengthy illness.

Born on June 3, 1949 in Mansfield, Ohio to Jasper and Doris (Berno) Stricker, Nancy attended Sandusky High School and later worked for Ohio State University. She lived for many years in Columbus' historic German Village and enjoyed the areas parks, coffee shops, and bookstores. Nancy was the author and illustrator of 4 books, was a prolific book collector, enjoyed reading, music and the fine arts, and was an animal rights advocate, rescuing many animals and volunteering at numerous animal rights organizations.
