He would wake us up in the morning singing a goofy song, just trying to get us to smile before going to school.

He lived with me while Mom was in a nursing home less than a mile away from us. She battles with Alzheimer's disease. We lost both of my sisters during this time. Dad and I leaned on each other a lot. I walked in his room one day and told him I felt like giving up. He said, "Never give up, your true spirit guide/God will see you through." That was the best advice he ever gave me. "He loved playing pool

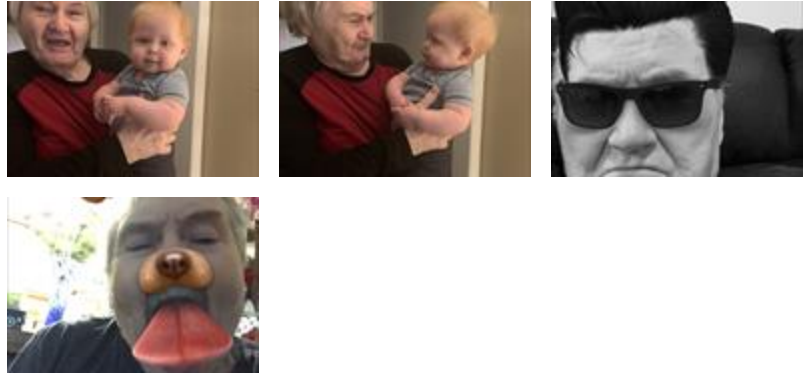
