Norbert George "Hans" Brun, age 94, of Columbus, Ohio died May 6, 2016. He was born June 11, 1921 in Hamler, Ohio to the late Harmon and Mary Brun. He is preceded in death by his stepmother, Anna, his brothers, Richard and Walden, and sister, Olga Brenner. Norb is survived by his beloved wife of 69 years, Anna Mae, and their children: Linda (Dave) Carden, Jane (John) Porter, Kathy (Marty) Stalnaker, Steve (Jane) Brun, and Scott Brun.
