Roland Girard Berry, age 82, passed away on February 2, 2026, in Grove City, Ohio, surrounded by family and friends.

Born on April 15, 1943, in Windsor Township, North Carolina, Roland was the son of Milton Berry and Mabel Bernice Watson both of whom preceded him in death. Roland was also preceded in death by his siblings, Andrew Craig, Leroy Craig and Martha (Oday) Berry.
