



Ronald "Ron" Eugene Stoll

Ron finished his race on Wednesday, Dec 7th. Ron is preceded in death by his parents Forrest and Dorothy (Miller) Stoll and his brother Forrest Stoll Jr. He is survived by his loving wife of 59 years, Leah (Marsh) Stoll; sons, Kenneth Stoll and Robert Stoll; grandchildren, Christopher Stoll and Maegan (Stoll) Furst. Born at White Cross hospital, Ron was adopted by Forrest and Dorothy at 15 months when his birth mother died. The Stoll's raised Ron to love and serve God. He served our country as a member of the Navy Reserves. Ron was a valued worker and finished his career at Sears Roebuck & Co after 31 years of service. Ron served God all his life, working around the church and participating in several Work & Witness trips using the skills he learned in his younger days. He is visible in pictures from these trips as the man with the red suspenders. God also used Ron's skills at several churches around Ohio and at the Logan Conference Center. Partnering with Leah, Ron was very active in NMI, where he headed up Child Sponsorship and initiated the SCO CCK/SPP shipping program providing low cost transportation for boxed kits to the warehouse in Fawn Grove. Ron has left behind shoes that are too big to fill. A memorial service will be held at 12pm on December 12th at Westerville Church of the Nazarene, 355 Cherrington Rd, Westerville, OH 43081.
