



## Sharon Kay (Hoffhein) Rubinow

May 29, 1946 - July 14, 2018

Sharon Kay (Hoffhein) Rubinow, age 72, passed away peacefully at Mt. Carmel St. Ann's hospital in Westerville, Ohio, Saturday, July 14, 2018, surrounded by her family. Sharon was born in Marion, Ohio, on May 29, 1946, to David Ralph and Anzie Louise Hoffhein.
