Shelba Jean McNicol (82) of Lancaster, Ohio passed into the waiting arms of her Lord and Savior, surrounded by family and friends at the Pickering House in Lancaster, Ohio on Friday, July 25, 2025.

She was born in Urbana, Ohio on February 8, 1943 and moved to Lancaster, Ohio in the early 1970's. She was an avid quilter, entering multiple quilts into the Fairfield County Fair, winning several ribbons, and did quilting for others, even as far away as New York. 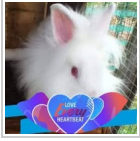
