Sonja H. Lacey passed away January 25, 2019 at the age of 80. Sonja was born April 25, 1938, in St. Louis, MO to Bertha Finley Hill and Lemar Hill. At the age of 12, Sonja was baptized at Mount Zion Baptist Church under the leadership of Reverend Baker. In her early years, she was artistic and creative. She attended Harriet-Stowe Teacher's College and transferred to Washington University in St. Louis, MO after enrolling in one of their Design programs for a few years. She loved to sew and often designed the clothing, hats, and home accessories for family and friends. She met Warrick Lacey Sr. at a debutante ball in St. Louis, while he was serving in the United States Air Force. He was invited to be her escort and sparks flew. They married once he was discharged from the Air Force. In the early 1960s, Sonja and Warrick moved to Columbus, OH. Sonja worked at the Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles until she retired on April 30 of 1999. Sonja loved to travel and enjoyed trips to Mexico, Canada, Costa Rica, and various islands in the Caribbean. She was an avid reader and passed the passion for reading on to her children. Sonja was also a big fan of her children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren, and as a result attended countless track meets, arts and craft shows, band concerts, football games, wrestling meets, basketball games, cheerleading competitions and dance performances in support of them. In her later years, she served as the primary caregiver to her husband and regularly attended morning water aerobics at the Jewish Community Center of Greater Columbus with lifetime friend Louise Fuller. Sonja will be remembered as a devoted wife; dear sister; a loving mother, aunt, grandmother, and great-grandmother; a compassionate friend; and above all, a kind and gentle spirit to all who were fortunate enough to cross paths with her.
