Thomas A. Stevenson Jr., age 80, passed away on July 25, 2022 in Carroll, Ohio. He was born July 8, 1942 in Abington, Massachusetts to the late Thomas and Marion Stevenson. Tom is also preceded in death by his sisters, Donna Stevenson and Linda Serino; and brother, Norman Stevenson.
