



## Tyrone Anthony Bryant

May 7, 1969 - March 24, 2022

Tyrone (Ty) Anthony Bryant, 52, of Columbus, Ohio passed away at his residence on March 24, 2022. Ty was born in Dayton, Ohio on May 7, 1969 to his parents Tyronne and the late Patricia Ann Bryant. Ty attended Greenview High School where he played varsity football, first chair trumpet in the concert band, and was an accomplished graphic artist. Ty also enjoyed singing and breakdancing. He loved singing worship songs and going to Karaoke events.

Ty studied Industrial Commercial Product Design, and was tops in his design class at the University of Cincinnati. He had multiple successful graphic and product designs. One exceptional design was for Phillips Corporation as his senior project and it was selected for commercial fabrication. The VCR actually went into commercial production while he was co-oping at Phillips in Knoxville, Tennessee. Following college, Ty lived briefly in the Dayton, Ohio area before moving to Columbus, Ohio and Chillicothe, Ohio where he pursued multiple career interests as an entrepreneur and product designer.
